Description

Philipp Peter Roos, known as Rosa da Tivoli, was a renowned 18th-century German painter, famous for his Arcadian scenes. His works unfold in idyllic landscapes where shepherds, nymphs, and animals inhabit lush vegetation, inspiring profound serenity. His technique also recalls the so-called "Bambocciate" style of painting, characterized by earthy tones and a palette dominated by browns. However, as in the work presented here, the artist offers portraits of animals--sheep and goats accompanied by a shepherd--rendered with sincere naturalism in a valley of warm hues and lush texture.
