Circa 1835-1840 France A bourgeois woman's bodice or camisole in mouse-grey silk faille and dating from the Romantic period. Curved bodice with small neckline and angled sleeves with small gigots. The back is cut in a V-shape and finished at the front with fine pleating and concealed period hooks. Beautiful boiled smocking on shoulders and arms, all seams finely piped in color. Caraco fully lined with cream chintz and brown chintz on the sleeves. Cuffs are fastened with color-coded buttons. No stains or holes. Very good color and condition. Dimensions: Equivalent size France 38.-39. Shoulders 42 cm, Sleeves 65 cm, Front height 48 cm, Back height 31 cm, Chest 102 cm, Waist 78 cm.
