Color of diamonds estimated H to J, purity estimated VS to SI. Belle Epoque, Circa 1910. White gold part on the back of the ring, cut later. Gross weight: 4.30g Finger size: 64 (diameter 20.35 / US 10.60). Pattern height: 1.90 cm Pattern width: 1.50 cm Condition: micro-scratches on gold and platinum parts, see photos.
