Description

Large, handsome painting of a richly decorated 18th-century interior with elegant people in charming conversation by the renowned Munich painter Johann Aldabert HEINE, born in 1850 and exhibited at the Munich Salon des Beaux Arts in 1890. Born around 1850, he was active in Munich. His work most often evokes scenes of Bavarian taverns or convent cellars. Outside this activity, he participated in Bruno Piglhein's panorama Jerusalem at the time of the Crucifixion of Christ on its original canvas and signed lower left, located in Munich, this work is characteristic of this painter's talent for rendering gallant scenes of interiors in the 18th century with great realism and perfect execution with shimmering colors. It has a rare and beautiful frame in gilded wood with 18-carat gold leaf (
