Originating in Iran, it dates back to the Shah period in the XXe century. It features an elegant midnight-blue field, delicately animated by a seedling of petals and birds arranged around a central vase with a diamond cabochon motif. The whole is framed by five borders, including a main ivory one adorned with finely drawn floral reserves. Cotton warp, weft and fringe.
