This pair of screens is made of boiled-pressed cardboard, with a black lacquered background. The decoration on one side features flowers and fruit on an entablature. Composed of mother-of-pearl inlays, it is with painted colors of plant motifs and gilded and gilded fillets. The other side is plain black, with no motif. The turned handles are partly varnished and gilded. One of the screens is in very good condition, while the second is visible on the photos. Napoleon III period - late 19th century.
