Description

Henri DASSON (1825-1896) All-sided salon table, opening with a drawer in the waist. It rests on a tapered base. Gilt bronze ornamentation decorated with flowering stems, acanthus leaves, ribbons and interlacing Louis XVI style Wood and veneer. Gilt bronze 69 cm length x 48.5 cm depth x 71.5 cm height. With a key. Perfect condition. Henri Dasson ____ His talent was widely recognized by his contemporaries: he won awards at every exhibition he took part in. At the 1878 Universal Exhibition, the international jury awarded him a gold medal. Four years later, at the 1882 Exposition des Arts Décoratifs, he again received this distinction and was made a Chevalier de la Légion d'Honneur. Considered one of the great cabinetmakers and bronzemakers of the second half of the 19th century, Henry Dasson
