Description

Elegant Flemish-inspired landscape depicting a lively riverside scene in a deep, structured wooded setting. The composition is organized around a sloping path leading to a river bordered by distant architecture and hills. In the foreground, a couple of figures in colorful costumes enliven the scene, while other figures scatter across the landscape, bringing life and narrative to the whole. The right-hand side is dominated by a group of powerful trees, with finely detailed foliage and richly textured materials. On the left, the view opens onto a vast, luminous panorama, structured by a river and picturesque buildings. Attribution This work was produced in the circle of Gillis II van Coninxloo, a major painter of the late 16th-century Flemish school, known for his structured forest landscapes

Characteristics of this tradition are found here: - deep construction with alternating dark and light areas - emphasis on tree masses - fine treatment of foliage - presence of small figures animating the landscape Good overall condition. Cracks and wear consistent with age. Landscapes from the circle of Gillis van Coninxloo testify to the evolution of Flemish landscape towards more naturalistic and immersive compositions, heralding the developments of landscape painting in the 17th century.
