Collectible cane with ivory pommel depicts the portrait of Henri III in period dress with his laurel wreath. Superb silver scroll decoration on the lower part. Presence of a hallmark. Malacca rush shaft and brass ferule. Nota : Son of Henri II and Catherine de Médicis, last King of the Valois dynasty, King of France from 1574 to 1589, elected King of Poland-Lithuania (1573-1575) under the name of Henryk Walezy. Dimensions: overall length 91.5 cm / pommel with ring 8.8 cm. France made in the middle of 19th century.
