Description

Elegant 18th-century still life with flowers, this oil on canvas charmingly illustrates the decorative tradition of European floral compositions. The bouquet, generous and lively, blends roses, tulips and flowers of varied inspiration in a loose, slightly asymmetrical composition. Here, the artist favors a sensitive rather than strictly botanical approach, with a lively touch that lends the whole an almost naïve freshness that is highly appealing. The palette, dominated by warm tones - oranges, creams and deep greens - stands out with refinement against a patinated brown background, typical of old painting, highlighting the luminosity of the flowers. The classic vase, sober and stable, balances the composition and emphasizes the abundance of the bouquet. Beyond its decorative
