The work features a childlike gathering imbued with bucolic poetry. In the center, a group bustles around baskets of red fruit, their tender gestures underscoring the innocence of the subject. This country motif, typical of the 19th century, explores the link between childhood and nature in a suspended atmosphere. Bottom, a sketch of everyday life suggests a social world in the making, contrasting with the carefree foreground. Markable for its treatment of matter

and spontaneity. The painter deploys a masterful chiaroscuro, where saturated vermilion reds and luminous whites pierce an atmosphere of broken-toned undergrowth. The brushstroke, free and pre-impressionist, favors luminist atmosphere over academic rigor. This is a fascinating technical testimony to the passage from sketch to color.
