



Vintage 14k Yellow Gold Solid Opal And Diamond Ring, 20th Century

Description

A refined 20th-century ring in 14K yellow gold, set with an oval solid opal cabochon of approximately 4 carats and framed by small diamond accents.

The opal displays a lively play-of-colour, with green, yellow and sky-blue flashes over a milky-pearl white base. Its single-piece structure and rich, even optical effect indicate a genuine solid opal rather than a composite stone.

The ring has a clean, flowing profile and a polished gold setting that gives it an elegant simplicity. The small diamonds add restrained brilliance and balance the composition without overwhelming the central stone. The style is characteristic of earlier 20th-century opal jewellery and suggests an Australian solid opal rather than a later hydrophane Ethiopian example.
