Large Bidjar rug with Garrus decoration, woven in high-quality kork wool, dating from the Shah era, circa 1950s. This model embodies the excellence of Persian craftsmanship, with a remarkable density of around 8000 to 9000 knots per square meter, guaranteeing great finesse of execution and exceptional durability. Its richly ornamented field features a harmonious palette ranging from emerald green to earthy brown tones, evoking a stylized landscape punctuated by cypress and floral motifs. The Garrus design, typical of Bidjar rugs from this period, is distinguished by its dense structure and decorative elegance. Each detail, entirely handcrafted, bears witness to the ancestral know-how of Iranian weaving workshops. A true piece of character, this rug combines robustness
