Elegant Louis XVI period (late 18th century) chest of drawers in veneer and inlaid walnut, plum and white/black fillets. It has an imposing size, but above all it is remarkable for the quality of its workmanship, the sturdiness of its frame, and the finesse of its marquetry. This is a typical example of cabinetmaking in eastern France, most probably Dijon. It opens with 3 drawers on the front, and is topped with a gray marble. The locks work, and each has a key. This piece of furniture has been restored and re-varnished by us. We are therefore offering a piece of furniture in perfect condition.
