Sublime kilim from Hakkari in the far east of Anatolia Woven from wool on wool in the traditional manner. The piece is composed of two sections joined and sewn together. Distinctive feature of most 19th and early 20th century pieces. This is definitely the work of the Kurdish populations who make up the majority in the far east of Turkey. Extremely tight, regular weaving. A work of art and a refined piece. Very beautiful vegetal hues in perfect harmony. Tones of indigo blue, midnight blue, madder red, red ochre... Like a signature, very beautiful braided fishnet bangs, the work of the Kurds. The indigo blues are to die for. Circa 1880/1900 Perfect condition, like new!
