Large pair of gilt bronze and patinated candelabra - 19th century
In the taste of Auguste Maximilien Delafontaine
Elegant and spectacular pair of three-light candelabra in finely chased gilded and patinated bronze, resting on light marble bases.
Each candelabra features a rich, refined composition: slender shaft adorned with plant motifs, light arms in the form of naturalistic branches, carved decoration of mythologically-inspired female masks, clawed tripod base, enhanced with fantastical heads, in a neo-Renaissance / eclectic spirit typical of the 19th century.
The contrast between the glossy gilding and the brown patina underlines the quality of the chasing work and lends great decorative depth.
