Relief depicting the NativityCoral (Corallium rubrum), carved and mosaiced.Rectangular-shaped devotional relief, framed by rich Baroque carved coral decoration. In the center, a finely-worked Nativity scene showing the Virgin and St. Joseph in adoration before the Child, accompanied by angels, against an architectural background. The set is surrounded by a mosaic of carved coral.The whole is surrounded by an ornamental frame with scrolls, floral motifs and shell elements, characteristic of Trapani production.The reverse is entirely covered with a mosaic of small coral plates in various hues, typical of these creations.Technique: carved coral, mounted on support, coral mosaic reverseCondition: small chips and edge wear, inherent to ageThe
