A spherical body, with a rounded base supported by 3 feet forming branches, wide spout with a moving rim. Flattened raised handle. HARD porcelain. White background with polychrome flowers. At the edge, a wide band with a brown background decorated with a garland of foliage interspersed with 2 circular reserves adorned with a rose, surrounded by gold fillets and garlands of foliage, gold fillets at the edges.
