HARD porcelain. White background, in the center, a round medallion encircled by a gold fillet and surmounted by a garland of foliage, with landscape decoration in sepia cameo. The border features a wide band decorated with a garland of roses on a gold stippled background, surrounded by gold garlands and fillets. Gold highlights on the handle. Dimension(s) : Height. 16.5 cm - Length. 15.3 cm, Condition : INTACT, Period : XVIIIth - LOUIS XVI, Observation(s) : Minimal minor wear - RARE MODEL. This form known as "HANAP or CASQUE" was very rarely used by Parisian
