Saint Suaire de Besançon début XVIII^{ème}
Gold-spun polychrome silk embroidery on a cream satin ground featuring a bishop accompanied by 2 canons presenting the shroud of Christ Below in a slightly oval frame is the Virgin and Child Jesus . All faces are painted and of fine quality This embroidery is presented in a Bérain frame From its annexation by the Kingdom of France (1668 and 1674) , artistic and especially religious life was intense in Besançon and numerous commissions took place Among all these artistic achievements , an important part was given to the Holy Shroud of Besançon , the city , at that time was the object , of an important pilgrimage and numerous churches had come into being .
