Description

Superb solid oak hunting sideboard, Louis XV, dating from the XVIIIe century, displaying very fine craftsmanship and proportions. The cabinet opens at the front with two richly molded leaves, adorned with moving panels with scalloped decor typical of the Louis XV taste. The front is highlighted by an elegant central crosspiece embellished with carved circular medallions, bringing rhythm and refinement to the whole. The cut-out, sinuous lower belt rests on cambered feet at the front, characteristic of furniture from this period. The sides are also panelled and moulded, testifying to meticulous workmanship on all visible faces. The wood features magnificent oak graining, enhanced by a warm patina in honey and amber tones, revealing all the charm and authenticity of the XVIIIe century. The top shelf

is topped with moulded Campan marble, a traditional element of hunting sideboards, offering both elegance and functionality. Furniture stamped Nicolas Duval, (reçu Maître le 11 août 1743) a recognized cabinetmaker of the XVIIIe century, reinforcing its historical interest and value for antique furniture enthusiasts. Very good overall condition, with a remarkable decorative presence, ideal for a classic or contemporary interior looking for a piece of character. It measures 123 CM in Length , 66 CM in Depth and 80 CM in Height .
