In the foreground, a young woman, kneeling, busies herself with dishes, surrounded by finely depicted copper and earthenware utensils. In the center of the composition, a female figure holding a child stands out in soft light, while in the background, other characters take part in the daily life of the farm. The space opens onto a broadly structured architecture, blending dark interior and bright exterior, with a perspective overlooking a tree-lined courtyard where a meal scene unfolds. The composition, rich and balanced, skillfully combines figures, still life and architecture. The treatment of light, the marked contrasts and the liveliness of the attitudes give the whole a great
