### Description

Moving depiction of Christ on the cross, treated with great dramatic intensity in the deep chiaroscuro characteristic of 17th-century painting. The slender body of Christ, bathed in cold light, stands out powerfully against a dark, almost nocturnal background. Head tilted skyward, arms outstretched, the figure expresses restrained suffering imbued with spirituality. The anatomical treatment, precise and sensitive, accentuates the human and sacred dimension of the subject. In the background, subtle touches of light hint at a distant landscape, reinforcing the depth of the composition and the dramatic solitude of the scene. This work is part of the tradition of 17th-century European schools, marked by the influence of Caravaggesque naturalism: strong contrast between light and
