The son of sculptor Adolfo Cipriani and Emilia Pancani, Ugo Cipriani was the fifth child of nine siblings. He lives in the Oltrarno district, at Borgo San Frediano. After studying at Florence's Academy of Fine Arts, Ugo Cipriani worked in marble, terracotta, bronze and alabaster

One of his best-known works, a bronze monument (1919) to the Italian nationalist and irredentist Guglielmo Oberdan, stands in Florence's piazza of the same name. In 1935, Ugo Cipriani emigrated to France to escape Mussolini's fascist regime. He lived in Paris as a political refugee and continued to create there until his death in 1960. A very prolific sculptor in France, certain clues revealed by his daughter Lydia and son Gabriel suggest that he used pseudonyms such as Menneville and Uriano.
