Description

Superb Karabakh Maffrash from Armenia in the Caucasus. Few Maffrash offer such dimensions. Technique Mixed wool on wool, woven and Sumak for the two large outer panels. Maffrash are the largest carrying bags formerly used by the nomadic populations of Persia and the Caucasus. On this one we observe a rather varied palette of hues with the usual and unexpected presence of a sparkling yellow. The indigo blues are delightful. All these vegetal hues are dense and saturated, giving this Maffrash an ultra-luminous appearance, with beautiful depths, particularly in the central part, composed of successive thin horizontal stripes to great effect. This composition in two panels with embroidered motifs linked by a plainer central section is the hallmark of all Maffrash. Perfect
