The piece is distinguished by a beautiful harmony of gradated colors, blending green, pink and amber tones, against an opalescent background. The stylized foliage decoration, treated in reserve, offers a subtle interplay between transparency and material, characteristic of Gallé's savoir-faire. The slender shape of the soliflore, with its rounded body and long, slender neck, accentuates the elegance of the whole and highlights the naturalistic decoration.
