Superb fragment of Karabakh Maffrash from Armenia in the Caucasus. Maffrash were the largest carrying bags used by the nomadic populations of Persia and the Caucasus. This fragment corresponds to one of the 2 large panels. Sumak wool-on-wool technique. The piece is in near-miraculous condition. At first glance, you're instantly seduced by the multiple reflections of the indigo blues. Their freshness and purity create a kind of relief on the surface. It's wonderful.
