Decoreis, and dated 1860.This elegant composition depicts a lively seaside scene, where a boat occupied by figures stands out in the foreground, at the foot of a coastal fortification. The whole is treated in a harmonious palette blending delicate blues, sandy tones and mineral nuances, characteristic of 19th-century marine painting.The subtly shaded, slightly impastoed work on the sky brings light and depth to the scene, while the precise treatment of figures and architecture lends the work great legibility and genuine narrative charm.An active painter in the south of France in the 19th century, Pierre Decoreis followed in the tradition of the

landscape and marine painters of his time, influenced by naturalism and the beginnings of a more sensitive approach to light. The work is presented in its antique 19th-century oval-shaped frame in carved and gilded wood, perfectly suited to the composition. Good overall condition, with light wear consistent with its age.
