Dimensions: Top: 42.5 x 42.5 cm - Base: 46 x 46 cm - Height: 76 cm
Artistic collaborations: In the early 20th century, Kohn collaborated with artists from the Wiener Werkstätte (such as Josef Hoffmann, Koloman Moser and Adolf Loos) to create models in the Viennese Secession style, following the example of Thonet.
Merger: Thonet and J&J Kohn join forces and merge in 1922, following the economic difficulties encountered after the First World War.
Standing Art Nouveau bentwood fifth wheel from the early 20th century, made by the renowned Austrian firm Jacob & Josef Kohn circa 1910-1920. This timelessly designed fifth wheel (Model No. 960) features a square top and suspended compartment. Delicately curved and artistically crafted legs - just admire the finely worked
