



## A Young Woman Painter At Her Easel

### Description

Concentrated, her brush resting on the finished etoupe cane that rests on the edge of the frame, this young woman applies herself to her work placed on a studio easel. At her side is her messy box of paints, and at her back a shelf where a painting is drying, turned upside down to avoid dust. All these little details show the artist's habit of working, not a staging, but a snapshot of an artist's life in her studio. Alas, we know nothing about her; on the back of the stretcher of this painting, an attribution in pencil and a date, 1821, and a name that is difficult to read (Jean...?) The painting is currently, as the photos attest, in good original condition; minor wear on the hairstyle will be corrected next week by my restorer, giving a perfect reading of the painting. A lovely period frame in good condition perfectly
