Description

Nineteenth-century paperback book with named provenance - dated 1842. Superb devotional reliquary dating from the first half of the century, presented in an elegant square glass frame preserved in its original mounting. The set is distinguished by a refined decoration of paperolles, typical of 19th-century convent production, embellished with floral motifs and symbolic elements. The central medallion, of a Christian nature, is harmoniously set off by a rich, balanced composition. The real interest of this piece lies in its document preserved on the back, providing a rare traceability: - Mention of transmission to Madame Lamarre - Explicit indication "remis par ses héritiers" - Date clearly
