Materials and treatment - Glass quality: These objects were made from high-quality, transparent or colored glass, often enriched with metal oxides to achieve intense hues (sapphire, emerald, ruby). - Polishing: Surfaces and facets were carefully polished to create a shiny texture that reflected light beautifully. - Gilding: - Gilding was applied by hand using gold leaf or a liquid gold solution. - Designs included vegetal themes (leaves, flowers), medallions and geometric motifs. - Gilding could be combined with enamel paints to add colorful accents.
