Description

A remarkable, atmospheric 19th-century French church candlestick in richly patinated copper, designed for religious interiors. This impressive piece bears witness to the devotional craftsmanship of the period, when liturgical objects embodied both spiritual symbolism and craftsmanship excellence. The tall, twisted central column rises with sculptural presence, terminating in a wide circular cup with a central spike designed to accommodate a large candle. The expressive pedestal rests on three shapely feet and is adorned with refined details typical of late 19th-century French ironwork. Its warm, weathered surface bears the deep mark of decades of use, giving it authenticity and character. Originally intended for church aisles, chapels or ceremonial spaces, today this candlestick is a
