### Description

Louis-Alexandre CABIÉ (Dol-de-Bretagne 1853 - Bordeaux 1939) Les meules de foin Oil on paper layed on canvas H. 28.5 cm; L. 32 cm Signed lower right, dated 1926 Louis Cabié, a renowned artist in France and particularly in the Bordeaux region, even during his lifetime, circulated in the greater Southwest throughout his life. A pupil of Harpignies, whose passion for vegetation is reminiscent of the Barbizon school, he remained faithful to the simplicity of picturesque French landscapes until his death. Spectacular trees, forest atmospheres, places steeped in history, bewitching valleys, or even a landscape in its simplest form, which he was able to enhance with a vital contrast.
