Description

A refined example of early Belgian Art Deco, this 1920s chair illustrates the movement's evolution towards modern geometry, while retaining the warmth and craftsmanship of traditional cabinetmaking. Its architectural structure, composed of sturdy, linear wooden elements, draws a sculptural silhouette that is both grounded and dynamic, characteristic of Belgian interwar design. The chair has recently been reupholstered in a rich red fabric that echoes the bold, expressive palette often associated with this period. The new upholstery highlights the clean contours of the seat and back, providing a striking contrast to the dark wood with its elegant patina. Together, these elements create a remarkable interplay of color and form, giving the piece a renewed presence without compromising its
