### Description

These elegant Belgian Art Deco chairs, dating from around 1920, bear witness to the boldness and modernity that marked the interwar period. Their wooden structures, with their straight, assertive lines, express the movement's fascination with structure, symmetry and craftsmanship. Their almost sculptural silhouettes create a resolutely contemporary rhythm and balance thanks to the continuity of the shapes of the armrests and legs. Recently reupholstered in a bright red fabric, these chairs assert their graphic presence while paying homage to the expressive palettes often favored in early Art Deco interiors. The new upholstery emphasizes the precise geometry of the seats and backrests, offering a vibrant contrast with the dark, beautifully patinated wood. The result is a harmonious

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dialogue between rediscovered comfort and preserved authenticity. Originally designed for refined salons or modernist professional interiors, today these chairs are a sophisticated decorative element in contemporary spaces; ideal as occasional chairs, gallery seating or centerpieces of a carefully selected Art Deco collection. Their generous yet rigorous proportions, their craftsmanship undeniably typical of their era, and their overall presence both warm and architecturally assertive. A rare and beautifully restored ensemble that clearly and stylishly infuses the spirit of early Belgian Art Deco into our own time.
