Description

This charming Belgian Art Deco stool, dating from the 1920s, embodies the early modernist spirit of the movement in a compact, sculptural form. Its distinctive silhouette, defined by boldly shaped wooden supports and a gently curved seat, reflects the era's fascination with geometry, craftsmanship and the interplay between structure and ornament. The design, both architectural and welcoming, offers a balance characteristic of Belgian decorative arts in the years following the First World War. The seat has recently been reupholstered in a bright red fabric, a choice that reinforces the stool's expressive presence while paying homage to the deep, rich tones often found in period interiors. The new upholstery accentuates the soft contours of the cushion, creating a striking contrast with the dark,

weathered wood. Despite its modest dimensions, the stool has a strong visual rhythm, making it an elegant element in contemporary spaces as well as historically inspired interiors. Originally conceived as both a functional and decorative element within a refined Art Deco interior, the stool now elegantly stands out as a centerpiece in its own right. Ideal at the foot of a bed, next to an armchair or as a sculptural object in a carefully arranged room, this sofa stands out for its craftsmanship, harmonious proportions and renovated upholstery. Originally designed for refined private living rooms or modernist professional interiors, it is now a sophisticated focal point in contemporary spaces. Ideal for a reading corner, a designer lounge or a carefully selected Art Deco collection. The combination of sculptural presence, meticulous craftsmanship and revisited comfort makes this set a rare and fascinating example of Belgian Art Deco in all its splendor.
