This fascinating sculptural bottle is an exceptional decorative object, worthy of the finest contemporary cabinets of curiosities. Made in the 1980s, it draws inspiration from traditional Asian or Oriental votive forms. Probably designed as a ceremonial vase or a highly symbolic object, it captivates with its mysterious allure and the incredible complexity of its craftsmanship, combining noble materials with strong symbolism. Standing an impressive 43 cm tall, the piece commands attention with its harmonious proportions. The turned wooden core, forming a generous 20 cm bulbous body, is entirely covered in a luxurious horn veneer worked into twisted gadroons. This raised pattern subtly catches the light on the brown and translucent reflections of the organic material. The refinement is taken to

its peak with an elegant neck and stopper crafted from solid brass, delicately crowned with a decorative pearl finial.
