Vase made using the cloisonné technique (cloisonné enamel on a copper vessel). The main motifs are roses in bloom (symbolizing beauty and transience) and a bird in flight (probably a sparrow or swallow). The plant details are executed with extraordinary precision - there is a gradation of colors (enamel gradation) within the petals and leaves, giving them a three-dimensional appearance. Japan, Meiji / Taisho period, early 20th century. Height 30.5 cm, diameter 11.5 cm. Very good condition. Free shipping within the European Union! I send parcels by insured mail (DPD or DHL).
