Description

Decorative object representing an armillary sphere resting on a green patina bronze figure of Atlas, dating from 1970-1980. The figure, treated in a classical spirit, is depicted supporting the celestial whole, a direct reference to the traditional iconography of Atlas carrying the vault of the world. The sphere is composed of concentric metal rings forming a stylized armilla, with a central element depicting the globe. The whole presents a highly decorative neoclassical aesthetic, inspired by ancient scientific instruments. The Atlas figure rests on a circular black marble base, providing stability and elegant contrast with the bronze patina. This type of object was highly appreciated as a decorative element of a desk or library in the second half of the twentieth century. Atlas rests on a circular
