Description

Oil on canvas. Original canvas. This large-format canvas reinterprets the two-dimensional hieratic style of the Santa María de Maderuelo Hermitage, revisiting the Genesis scene through the electrifying, liberating prism of the 1960s. In this composition, the figures of Adam and Eve are freed from the rigidity of original sin to adopt a physiognomy of unbridled, organic sensuality. The serpent is no longer simply the symbol of the Fall, but the driving force behind a transgressive curiosity that celebrates knowledge. The black lines, characteristic of Castilian Romanesque architecture, take on a psychedelic vibrancy here, transforming the forbidden fruit into an emblem of sensory liberation. It's an encounter where 12th-century austerity merges with the spirit of a decade that aspired to tear down all walls,
