Description

This piece takes the form of a compact chest of drawers resting on four slender compass legs, a signature of 50s-60s design. The sober front is punctuated by three drawers with recessed oval handles in contrasting black, adding a discreet, refined graphic touch. The teak veneer, in warm, luminous shades, is carefully selected, highlighting fine, even veining. The remarkable feature of this piece lies in its transformable system:- The upper tray opens with a lift-up flap- The inside face of this flap is fully lined with a mirror- A second mirror is integrated into the lower part (tray), creating an interplay of reflections and real visual depth- The sliding tray unfolds towards the user, forming a functional shelf (dressing table or writing table) This ingenious device, typical of 60s design, perfectly
