Mahogany architect's desk, Louis XVI style, XIXe century. Elegant mahogany architect's desk, French work of the XIXe century in the Louis XVI style. The rectangular top is sheathed in leather framed by a gilded frieze and can be tilted, allowing comfortable use for drawing or writing. It reveals a compartmentalized interior featuring several storage compartments as well as a small central drawer. The front opens with a large compartmentalized drawer, adorned with two round bronze handles and a central keyhole. The piece rests on four straight, slender legs, characteristic of the Louis XVI style, giving the whole a sober, elegant line.
