An elegant pair of decorative sculptures of French manufacture, dating back to the early 19th century, crafted from refined biscuit on a composite base of red marble and gilded bronze. The figures, inspired by the iconography of classical antiquity, depict two mythological figures: a draped female figure wearing a helmet, identifiable as Minerva/Athena, and a male figure armed with a shield, identifiable as Mars/Ares. The modeling is fine and detailed, with particular attention to the draperies, anatomical proportions, and decorative elements, typical of French neoclassical production. The biscuit, with its matte and velvety surface, enhances the purity of the forms and the delicacy of the faces, while the red marble bases, embellished with elegant frames in finely chiseled gilded bronze, lend solidity and
