### Description

Superb bronze sculpture of a panther, created around 1930 by French sculptor Irénée Rochard, an emblematic figure of Art Deco. This work aptly embodies all the modernity and elegance of the Art Deco movement: a pure, taut, almost silent line, where every curve translates the restrained power and natural grace of the feline. The low, elongated posture, typical of Rochard's panthers, expresses a controlled tension, giving the sculpture a presence that is both discreet and captivating. The quality of the casting is remarkable, sublimated by a very beautiful golden-brown patina with deep nuances, highlighting the subtle modelling of the body and the precise workmanship of the volumes. The set rests on an elegant base in black Belgian marble, reinforcing the contrast and sophistication of the
