**Description**

Pierre Jacquet (20th century): "Paris, les boulevards sous la neige" An evocative mid-century Parisian winter street scene This charming oil on panel by French artist Pierre Jacquet captures the "City of Light" under a soft winter snow. Entitled Paris, les boulevards sous la neige, the work is an emblematic example of the twentieth-century Parisian school, emphasizing the atmosphere, movement and nostalgic architecture of the French capital. The composition centers around a classic green tramway - a nostalgic symbol of early-to-mid-twentieth-century Paris - moving along a wide, snow-covered boulevard. Jacquet brilliantly balances the cold, silvery-gray palette of a winter's day with the soft golden glow emanating from the streetcar's windows and

interior, creating a scene that is both lively and peaceful. Pierre Jacquet was a passionate chronicler of Parisian life. Following in the footsteps of the great Impressionist and Post-Impressionist flâneurs, Jacquet specialized in depicting the city's iconic boulevards through the seasons. His style is characterized by a fluid pictorial touch that favors atmosphere and light over rigid architectural details. Using a panel support, Jacquet achieves a smooth, luminous surface that perfectly embraces the misty, reflective qualities of a city under snow. His works are highly sought-after by collectors eager to capture the romantic, timeless spirit of the Belle Époque at the dawn of the modern era. The painting is presented in a sophisticated, mid-century-style frame with wide contours. This frame features: a dark, chocolate-colored exterior wood molding; a luxurious gilded interior bevel that draws the eye to the light at the heart of the canvas; and a traditional linen or fabric passe-partout, ensuring a smooth transition between the work and the frame.
