Rare and enchanting polychrome porcelain nightlight named porcelain by Camille Tharaud (1878-1956) This Art Deco model was created in 1927 and is listed in Jean Marc Ferrer's book (Camille Tharaud, l'art de la porcelaine de grand feu). Ferrer (Camille Tharaud, l'art de la porcelaine de grand feu) .P 45 .This nightlight is signed on the inside: signature in black associated with the green stamp, which allows us to date its manufacture to the period 1928-1930.
