Description

Oil on canvas. This scene is part of a series of twelve copper engravings by David Teniers illustrating Tasso's *Jerusalem Delivered*, and in particular Song XV. The work recreates the arrival of Godefroy's messengers on the island of Fortuna, where a classically inspired circular temple stands, evoking both the palace of the magician Armide and Andrea Schiavone's influence on the composition. The painting as a whole captures the essence of Flemish Baroque, fusing the epic heroism and amorous lyricism of the Italian poem. Image dimensions unframed: 31 x 18 cm / 44 x 30.5 cm with custom frame.
