Venetian painter (19th cent.) - Venice, view of the Royal Gardens with the Coffee House facing the Basilica of Santa Maria della Salute. 15 x 23 cm (unframed) - 22 x 30 cm (framed). Tempera on paper, in a carved and gilded wooden frame. Bears a pencil inscription on the reverse: "The gardens in Venice - Royal Gardens?". The view depicts St. Mark's Basin with the Doge's Palace in the foreground on the left. Along the Riva degli Schiavoni, figures in 19th-century attire come to life, alongside moored gondolas and sailing boats, while the background is framed by a sunset sky in shades of orange and pink. The liveliness of the figures and the atmospheric rendering recall the typical repertoire of early 19th-century Venetian landscape painters. Condition report: Paper mounted on canvas.
