Magnificent salon painting of a cardinal at the end of a meal with two elegant ladies admiring an aquarium with goldfish, signed lower right, on its original canvas and superbly framed in original Louis XV-style gilded and molded stucco from the post-Napoleon III period. High-quality execution and highly representative of the master's stylistic mastery. A genre painter and a great specialist in representations of the Cardinals, he was a member of the Salon des Artistes Français where he exhibited from 1892. He also exhibited in Monte Carlo, Antwerp, London, the USA and Germany. His meticulously-executed canvases evoke the comfortable existence of the Cardinals, lovers of the arts and good food. He was a pupil of JONCHÈRE with Ernest MEISSONNIER.
